

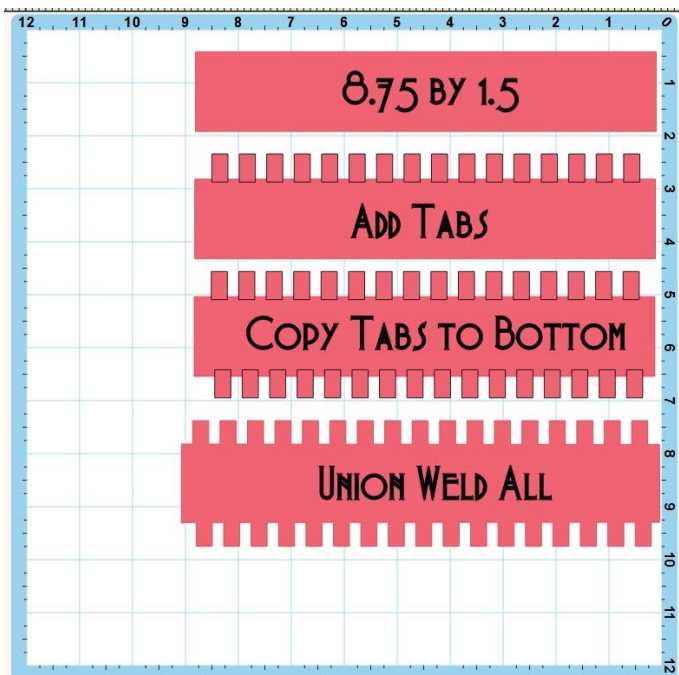


Dimensional Hat and Cake

Instructions:

Create the hat band. The band will have tabs to adhere it to the scallop circles. Draw a 1.5 inch high by 8.75 inch rectangle for the band. Draw a smaller rectangle for the tabs. Use the multiply tool to add tabs the length of the band. Copy the row of tabs to the top/bottom of the band. Select all these pieces and union weld. (If you choose, you can now add dashed lines where the tabs meet the band.)



Assemble the Hat

Cut scallop circles at 3 and 4 inches round. Cut a one inch circle in the center of the 4 inch scallop (hat

base). This will allow your finger access to glue the cut tabs to scalloped cardstock base. Adhere the short ends of the band. Fold the tabs to the center of the circle that you created with the band. Adhere tabs to the TOP scallop, forming a symmetrical circle as you go.



Now adhere the other end of the band to the BOTTOM scallop. At this point you may choose to add an additional scallop to your base to hide the opening.



Embellish the Hat

Add the eyelet border, flowers, pearls and ribbons as you like.

Assemble the Cake

Follow the above directions, but cut an additional smaller layer using a 2 inch scalloped circle. Take note to start assembling the cake from the TOP layer down.
