

Sunflower instructions

I cut three sets of petals and chalked each and glued them on top of each other and then crushed and shaped them in my hands. I dabbed gold, white and black paint on the center of the flower, then glued it to the center of the petal part of the flower.

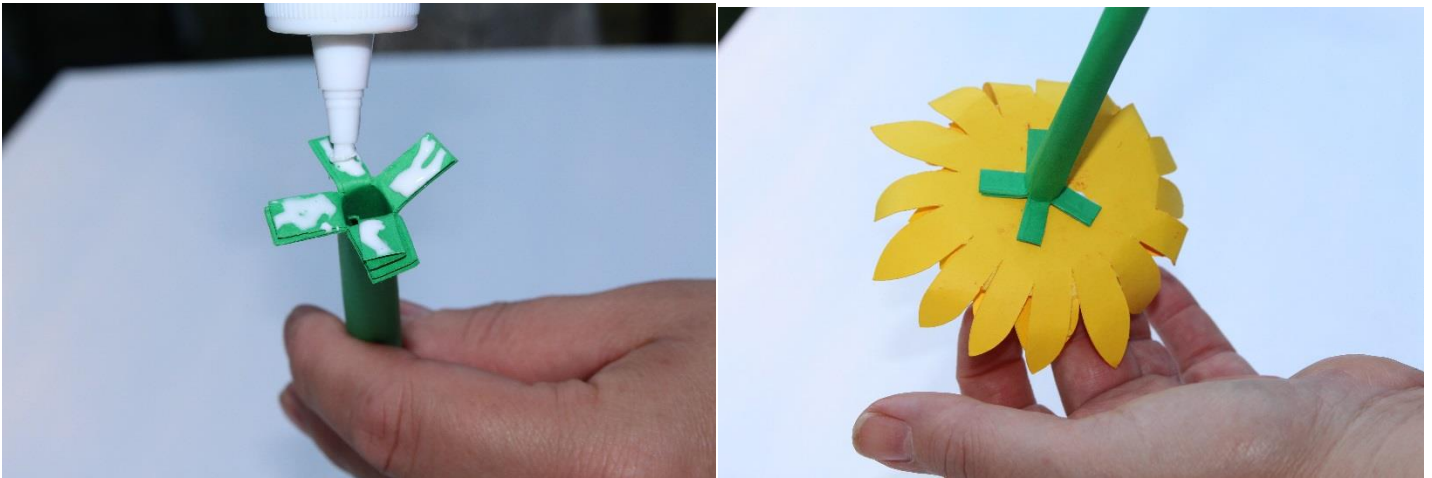
Next I rolled the stem. Remember sunflower stems are thick so you don't have to roll it tight. Once my paper was rolled I just glued the end and let it dry.



Next I flattened one end of the stem and cut a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch slit down the center. Then I flattened the same end in the opposite direction and cut another slit about $\frac{1}{2}$ inch down the center. If done correctly you should have 4 "flaps" to fold down.



Apply glue to all four flaps and adhere it to the back of the flower head.



Once the flower is dry, bend the stem and add the leaves.



Your flower is complete!



For the tin vase I just followed the instructions for the coffee cup. Although I added two rings around the vase and a handle on each side. The handles and rings are included in the file.
